
MANUFACTURING in MAINE

BUILD -

Manufacturing in Maine:

- Accounts for 9.8% (\$6.31 billion) of Total Output in State
 - 5th Largest Sector
- Employs 8.27% (1.2 million) of Total Workforce in State
 - 3rd Largest Sector
- Manufacturing Average Wage
 - 4th Highest Classified Average Wage
 - 2nd Highest in Total Wages
 - 56,700 jobs with an Average Annual Wage of \$64,272.00

MANUFACTURING in MAINE

GROW -

Manufacturing in Maine:

- 17% Sector Growth Year Over Year (2019 from 2018) in Maine
 - One of the highest sectors
- 7% Wage Growth 2019-2020
- Major investments into Maine Advanced Manufacturing sector for larger growth

Maine Manufacturing continues to show solid growth and expansion capability, especially compared to other sectors.


MANUFACTURING in MAINE

SUSTAIN -

Manufacturing in Maine:

- Covid 19 manufacturing in the state has rebounded to 80% of pre-covid levels.
 - Compared to only 60% in other major sectors
- Manufacturing in Maine has sustained continued growth over the last 5 years.
 - Other sectors fluctuate
- \$104.6k GDP/Employee in Advanced Manufacturing in Maine
 - 19% above state average

Manufacturing in Maine has shown consistent sustainability for Maine's people and Maine's economy.



MANUFACTURING for the PEOPLE, for the STATE

- Provides life-long career opportunities and income stability to Mainers of all backgrounds and educational levels.
- Jobs provide skills training that is transferrable.
- Builds communities by providing anchor companies and good paying jobs.
- Is capital intensive utilizing the products and services of multiple sectors from financing to IT to communication to additional manufacturing.
- Manufacturing dollars have a multiplier effect economically throughout the community and state by a factor of 3.6 according to Manufacturers Alliance of Productivity and Innovation (MAPI). For every dollar produced by manufacturing, an additional \$3.60 dollars are added through its outside value stream of products and services.





Manufacturing – State of the State

THE NEED TO EXPAND ON A MANUFACTURING FRIENDLY STATE

- CNBC 2021 study ranks Maine 48th in overall business climate
 - 49th in Workforce
 - 50th in Infrastructure
 - 37th in Economy
 - 40th in Cost of Doing Business
 - 42nd in Technology and Innovation
- Highest Corporate Tax Rates in New England
- 7th highest Corporate Tax Rates in the U.S.
- New England has the highest Utility Rates in the Country

Manufacturing needs a larger voice to advocate for changes to these statistics that will enhance instate manufacturing while drawing in outside and new manufacturing.

Manufacturing Retention & Expansion (MRE)

BUILD. GROW. SUSTAIN.

Manufacturing Retention & Expansion (MRE) is an economic development strategy that focuses on the retention and expansion of existing manufacturing businesses in this state.

- Existing companies account for 80% of job growth in the state vs. new business attraction.
- Manufacturers can utilize employees with high school level education to advanced degrees in engineering and IT

Workforce Development

- Through focused Workforce Development programs utilizing strategic partners to train workers for operation positions, management development and new technologies, MAME will help members grow, hire and retain workers.
- Strategic partners include: Destination Occupation, Express Pros, Learning Works, Maine Manufacturing Extension Partnership (MEP), U. of Maine Advanced Manufacturing Center(AMC), and our Business Growth Services (BGS) Professionals Network.
- Goal is to increase manufacturing jobs and the number of trained and available workers by 10% by 2023



Legislative Advocacy

MAME is the only voice in Augusta dedicated to supporting manufacturing and addressing their issues. Our focus is 100% on advocating for Pro-Growth, Pro-Manufacturing Legislation. Our work includes:

- Data collection from State and Federal resources focused on Maine's competitiveness compared to other New England states, and manufacturers across the country
- Engagement of state and local legislators through round table discussions to provide them with data of the economic impact from manufacturing, why this sector is so critical to Maine's economic recovery and long-term prosperity, and how proposed legislation affects this sector.
